The Summative ADEPT Formal Evaluation of Teachers (SAFE-T) is one of the major components of South Carolina's system for Assisting, Developing, and Evaluating Professional Teaching (ADEPT). As its name implies, the ADEPT system addresses teacher performance through three primary processes: assisting, developing, and evaluating. Since these processes are interrelated, all of them occur throughout each phase of a teacher's career continuum.

This System of ADEPT Formal Evaluation of Student Teachers includes multiple sources of evidence that reflect the student teacher's typical performance relative to each of the ten state performance standards and their related key elements.
