- o BEGINNING FALL 2020, in order to be placed for student teaching, teacher candidates must pass the state required PRAXIS Subject Assessments in the area of student teaching.
- o YEAR BEFORE STUDENT TEACHING: as of Fall 2020 students will pass Praxis II before STUDENT TEACHING.
- o Complete *state department application* at the SC Dept. of Education (CATS) <https://ed.sc.gov/educators/certification/cats/> - create a login/password - (initial certification process – *there is a fee!*) and complete the FBI fingerprint packet (*there is a fee!*)—by these *state due dates* if *Student Teaching in Fall - Feb. 15th - Student Teaching in Spring June 15th.*
- o Complete *Converse Request for Student Placement for Student Teaching* and electronically submit to Mrs. Linda Nicholls ([linda.nicholls@converse.edu](mailto:linda.nicholls@converse.edu)) if *Student Teaching in Fall - Feb. 15th - Student Teaching in Spring June 15th.*
- o Take Praxis II Subject Assessment(s) in your desired certification area. You must pass the Praxis II Subject Assessment(s) before you can student teach. Have ETS send original score report to both Converse (recipient code R5121) and SC Department of Education. Consult ETS and the SC Department of Education for appropriate Praxis II test.
