



Instructions for paying your bill or viewing your account balance

You can pay your bill in full by:

1. Having sufficient financial aid to cover all charges due.
2. Make payment in full before the due date.
3. Enroll in a sufficient payment plan to cover your charges.

Parents of ***undergraduate dependent students*** may apply for the Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loan by logging into [StudentAid.Gov](https://studentaid.gov) using the PARENT FSA USER ID. Parents who are first-time borrowers must also complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN). More information about the Parent PLUS loan program can be found [HERE](#).

Graduate students may apply for the GRAD PLUS LOAN by logging into [StudentAid.Gov](https://studentaid.gov) using the STUDENT FSA USER ID. Graduate students who are first-time GRAD PLUS borrowers must also complete GRAD PLUS Entrance Counseling and a Master Promissory Note (MPN).

Please remember that if you are a first-time student borrower (graduate and undergraduate) under the Federal Direct Loan Program, you MUST complete Federal Direct Loan Entrance Counseling and a Federal Direct Loan Master Promissory Note.
