



Converse Emerging Young Artists Juried Exhibition

March 11-23, 2024 Milliken Art Gallery at Converse University
Awards Ceremony and Reception 1-3pm, March 23, 2024 in the Gallery

Purpose: To provide a venue to recognize exemplary art works of high school students, to help them begin to prepare for a major in art while still in grades 9-12, and to introduce them to the Converse University Department of Art and Design and the variety of majors offered to students at Converse.

Awards: 1st; 2nd; 3rd place in each medium: Drawing, Painting, Mixed, Printmaking, Ceramics, Sculpture, Fibers, Digital Media, Photography; and Best in Show. **Note: online submission only.**

Guidelines:

- High school students grades 9-12 are eligible to enter through their art teacher.
- All media are eligible, except jewelry. No work is to be submitted that requires security cases.
- All work must be ready for display. If matted, use a neutral (white/cream/gray/black) mat with a 3" margin & cover with acetate. Back of work must include hanging apparatus and completed label below. No glass allowed in framing!
- 3-D work weight limit: Maximum 50 lbs.
- 2-D work size limit: Maximum 40 in. in either direction, including mat. Please note this limit!
- Students may submit 1 or 2 pieces through their art teacher. Each art teacher may submit up to 6 works of art at <https://airtable.com/appaBl7YDzXvJzvT4/shrltCMTSj9mrDwE4>
- Please submit a good quality jpeg image of each student's work. Sculptures should be photographed against a neutral background and 2D pieces should be cropped to the edge of the work. The file must have resolution of **at least 120ppi (pixels per inch) and no smaller than 3x5 in.** A pdf with more information on how to determine image size can be found at: Converse.edu/CEYA

By entering, photos of your work may be used for Converse Emerging Young Artists promotional materials.

This is a juried competition. Art teachers will be notified by February 21st of students whose works have been selected for the exhibition. Please put aside all work that it submitted so that it is readily available and in good condition if selected.

Event Schedule:

- Work will be on display in the Milliken Art Gallery between March 11th-23RD
- Reception will take place on March 23rd from 1-3pm
- Awards will be announced at 2pm
- Tours of the campus will be offered at 3:30pm
- Work can be taken home at 3pm. **MUST BE PICKED UP BY THE TEACHER THAT SUBMITTED IT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED AT DROP OFF.**

Deadlines and Delivery of Selected Works:

Entries MUST be received online by February 14th.

Selected Works can be delivered by hand to the on the following dates between March 6-9:

- Tuesday, March 5th 1-5pm
- Wednesday, March 6th 1-5pm
- Thursday, March 7th, 9am-12pm/ 1-5pm

If accepted work is being mailed, we MUST receive it by March 7th. Please send full postage and packing charges at time of submission if you want work mailed back.
