

2024-2025 Federal TEACH Grant Application

IMPORTANT: Federal TEACH Grants will be awarded to eligible students for the 2024-2025 academic year. Eligibility and award is based on term enrollment. Students will be reviewed every term to ensure GPA and program eligibility. This form must be received in Student Financial Aid at least 30 days prior to your last date of enrollment during the 2024-2025 academic year.

DIRECTIONS: Complete this form for consideration for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides **up to** \$4,000 per year (subject to funding approval by the U.S. Department of Education) (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate programs and \$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to students who commit to:

- 1. Teach full-time
- 2. Teach in high-need subject areas
- 3. Teach for at least four out of the first eight years after completing the teaching degree
- 4. Teach at schools that serve students from low-income families.
- 5. Be enrolled in one of the following TEACH Grant approved programs at Converse:
 - a. Undergraduate: Comprehensive Special Education, Special Education Learning Disabilities, Special Education Intellectual Disabilities, Special Education Deaf & Hard of Hearing, Minor in Secondary Education: Art Education, English, Math, Music Education, Social Studies, Science (Biology or Chemistry).
 - b. Graduate: Special Education Learning Disabilities, Special Education Intellectual Disabilities, Middle Level English, Middle Level Math, Middle Level Science, Middle Level Social Studies, Secondary Program – English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science Art Education, Music Education

NOTE: Failure to complete the service requirement and commitment for the TEACH Grant will result in the grant being converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.
